Health Requirements K-12

Please complete the following health requirements and return to the School Nurse/Health Office at Western CUSD 12. Please be advised that these are due 30 days after the first day of attendance by the student.

- Physical Exam-** Please use the physical form provided in this packet. The physical must be completed on the “State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination” stamped **11/2015**. If a physical is submitted on a different form it will not be accepted for the 2017-2018 school year.
 - Health History completed and signed by parent/guardian prior to evaluation by licensed health care provider.
 - Diabetes screening completed by licensed health care provider.
 - Lead screening on ALL children 6 years of age or younger.
 - Completed physical examination which is signed and dated by licensed health care provider.
- Dental Exam - Due May 15, 2018 (Kindergarten, 2nd, and 6th grades only)**
 - Completed on Illinois “Proof of School Dental Examination Form.” Exams completed after November 15, 2016 will be accepted for the 2017-2018 school year.
- Eye Exam -**
 - Completed on “State of Illinois Eye Examination Report” form.
- Immunization Record/Boosters**
 - Polio: 4 or more doses with the last dose received on/after the 4th birthday (K&1). 3 or more doses with the last dose received on/after the 4th birthday (2-12).
 - DTP/DTap/Td: 4 or more doses with the last dose received on/after the 4th birthday (K&1). 3 or more doses with the last dose received on/after the 4th birthday (2-12).
 - Tdap: 1 dose (6-12 grades will be required to show proof of receipt of one dose of Tdap vaccine, regardless of the interval since the last DTap, DT or Td dose)
 - Measles: 2 doses-1st dose must be on/after 1st birthday
 - Rubella: 2 doses-1st dose must be on/after 1st birthday
 - Mumps: 2 doses-1st dose must be on/after 1st birthday
 - Hepatitis B: 3 doses (Grades 6-12) administered at recommended intervals.
 - Varicella(Chickenpox): 2 doses-1st dose on/after 1st birthday or proof of the disease (K, 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12) All other grades 1 dose on/after 1st birthday or proof of the disease.
 - Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine: 6th and 7th graders 1 dose of MCV4 at school entry; the 1st dose received on or after the 10th birthday. 12th graders 2 doses of MCV4 at school entry; 2nd dose must be administered on or after 16th birthday. If the 1st dose is received at 16 years of age or older, only 1 dose is required.
