

**APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP

BARRY HIGH SCHOOL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION**

Scholarship recipients are limited to graduating seniors of Western Community Unit School District #12.

This scholarship is a one-year, non-renewable scholarship funded by donations from alumni of the former Barry School District. The amount of the scholarship and the number of scholarships awarded each year will be decided by the executive committee of the Barry High School Alumni Association and will be based upon the financial standing of the Alumni Association.

Selection is made primarily upon academic promise and financial need. The scholarship selection committee consists of five alumni of Barry High School who are members of, or are appointed by members of, the executive committee of Barry High School Alumni Association. The Superintendent, Principal, or Guidance Councilor of Western High School will serve as an ex-officio member of the selection committee, having an advisory vote only.

In the academic year immediately following high school graduation, one-half of the scholarship money will be awarded to the recipient after he or she provides proof of enrollment for the fall semester at a technical, two-, or four-year accredited college or university. The second one-half of the scholarship money will be awarded after the recipient provides proof of enrollment in the institution for the following spring semester.
