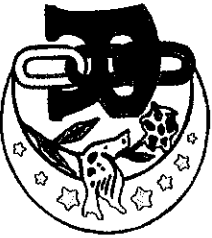
The Scholarship Program was instituted in 1985 by the Odd Fellows and Rebekahs of Illinois and is designed to assist qualified students needing Financial Aid.
