FARM BUREAUS OFFER \$5,000 IN SCHOLARSHIPS

Applications for Farm Bureau scholarships through the Two Rivers Farm Bureau Foundation are now available. The \$5,000 in scholarships are made possible through generous donations from Pike and Scott County Farm Bureau members.

- Two \$1,000 Scott County Farm Bureau scholarships will be awarded to successful applicants—one from Bluffs High School and one from Winchester High School.
- The \$1,000 Pike County Farm Bureau scholarship is available to a qualifying student from Pike County.
- The \$1,000 Rod Webel Memorial Scholarship is offered to qualified students who are dependents of Pike County Farm Bureau members and attend high school in Pike County.
- The \$1,000 Wayne Riley Scholarship is open to an FFA student graduating from Griggsville-Perry High School.

All the scholarships will be awarded to a graduating senior pursuing an education at a technical school, community college, college, or university of their choice and are a dependent of a Farm Bureau member. There is no course of study restriction but a major in an agricultural field will be given preference over other majors in the selection process.

Scholarships must be completed using the fillable-form found on the website. All scholarship applications must be returned by March 31.
