

Two Rivers Farm Bureau Foundation Scholarships

The Two Rivers Farm Bureau Foundation is offering five \$1,000 scholarships to qualifying students graduating from high schools in Pike and Scott counties in Illinois.

Scholarships available are two Scott County scholarships, a Pike County Scholarship, the Wayne Riley Memorial Scholarship, and the Rod Webel Memorial Scholarship.

The scholarships will be awarded to a graduating senior pursuing an education at a technical school or institute, trade school, community college, college, or university of their choice. **An agriculture** related major is required for all scholarships.

Selection will be based on the following criteria:

- Applicant must be a member, or the dependent of a member, of the Pike-Scott Farm Bureau;
- Student must mark the scholarship(s) for which they are applying (certain restrictions apply);
- Scholarship as evidenced by applicant's ACT/SAT score and a minimum 3.00 GPA (4 point scale);
- Leadership, school, and community activities;
- Completion of a short essay; and
- Two letters of recommendation from high school teachers or administrators.
